The sign of the Secular Franciscan Order in the USA is any form of the **TAU** cross. (Worn as a pin, a ring or a pendant.)

Our Minster General is Tibor Kauser, OFS

The International Fraternity Council—CIOFS--is made up of the Presidency (which would be akin to our National/Regional Executive Council and includes the Minister General, the Vice Minister General, the General Secretary, General Treasurer, the International Councilors representing language groups and the President of the Council of General Spiritual Assistants) and the National Ministers from all countries with a National Fraternity.

CIOFS (The International Fraternity Council) gathers once every three years for a Chapter. In intervening years, the Order is governed by the **Presidency.**

There are approximately 300,000 Secular Franciscans in the world

There are also a number of special committees established to serve the needs of the Order.

The National Fraternity Council of the USA (NAFRA) is made up of the National Executive Council, and the Ministers of all of the regions in the United States.

The **National Fraternity Council** gathers once a year in Chapter. In the intervening months, the **National Executive Council** conducts the business of the National Fraternity.

The entire **National Fraternity of the USA** is invited to attend the **Quinquennial** held every five years.

There are **30 Regions in the USA** with approximately **12,000 members** in almost **600** fraternities.

Our region is named Our Lady of the Angels Regional Fraternity.

The **Regional Fraternity** is made up of all the members of the fraternities which comprise our Region.

Our region is organized into **Clusters** which cover Northern NJ; Central NJ (including Staten Island) to Trenton; Manhattan, and Westchester

There are **30 local fraternities** in our region with **732 professed** members and **79 candidates**

We are the smallest region in geographic area and among the largest in number of professed and candidates in the USA

Our Lady of the Angels Regional Fraternity

The **Regional Fraternity Council** is made up of the Regional Executive Council and the Ministers of all of the local fraternities in our region.

The **Regional Fraternity Council** gathers once a year to conduct business at the **Chapter of Ministers** (usually held in November). The **Regional Executive Council** conducts the business of the Region in the intervening months.

Our Regional Spiritual Assistants are Fr. Frank McHugh, OFM and Bro. Lombardo D'Auria, OFM Cap. Regional Newsletter editor and Database Administrator- Anna Geraci and co-chairs of the Retired Friars Outreach Committee-Patricia Franz, Jody Pihokker and Maddi Romaine.

The entire **Regional Fraternity** gathers once a year, usually in April, for **Convivenza** which is our **Chapter of Mats**

Clusters gather periodically
