## LETTER FROM OUR REGIONAL MINISTER

JANUARY, 2017

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

As I write this we are quickly approaching the New Year. Your Regional Executive Council is filled with hope for our Order and for Our Lady of the Angels Region.

At the Chapter of Ministers in November, I reported to your Ministers on the state of our Region, and I would like to share with you some interesting facts and many of your wonderful accomplishments.



### OUR LADY OF THE ANGELS REGION — DID YOU KNOW?

**We have 30 fraternities** in our Region.

One fraternity and one Emerging Group have voted to deactivate. However, other fraternities are growing and getting stronger with **many new candidates!**

**Our Region measures 3,398** square miles in area; There are about **201** Secular Franciscans per 1,000 square miles.

We have **762 Active/Excused** professed members—only TAU Cross Region to our north and east is smaller and denser than we are.

**In 2016 we had 39 Candidates; 28 in Orientation and 11 Inquirers.**  
(Thanks to new vocations, these numbers have already grown going into 2017.)

**72%** of our members speak **English; 22% Korean; 2% Spanish; 3% Polish; Other 1%.**

We have **28 Spiritual Assistants.**  
(2 fraternities have no Spiritual Assistant. Please let us know if we can help!)

**Every fraternity paid its Fair Share in 2016—thank you!**

**Your Regional Minister and Council members** carried out **11 Visitations in 2016.**

We will have **presided at 20 local elections** by the beginning of 2017.

We heard that some fraternities would like to **“see even more of us.”**  
**Invite us** to attend Professions, celebrations, special talks, or a regular meeting.  
If we are available, we will be happy to attend.

**Our Regional newsletter, *The Troubadour*,** comes out four times a year (two are mailed). We also have an excellent publication called **OFS E-vents** which comes out via e-mail at the beginning of each month. Please contact **Anna Geraci, OFS,** if you have events to be listed.

Thank you to **local fraternity newsletter editors** who have been sending us copies!

**Our Website** has had **23,196 visits since its inception.**

**Our Facebook** page has more than **6,300 subscribers.**

### **We had an excellent SERVANT LEADERSHIP WORKSHOP THIS YEAR.**

We also had a **NORTH JERSEY CLUSTER FORMATION** class and plan to do this more often. (Both in NJ and in Manhattan.)

**CONVIVENZA**—The theme this year was the *Year of Mercy* with a pilgrimage to the Holy Doors in East Rutherford. The day was extremely well attended -- 175. We are hoping that this year's Convivenza will be just as special, so stay tuned.

15 members of our region attended the **QUINQUENNIAL** held in St. Louis in July.

**Our Yearly RETREAT** was well attended—suggestions from last year's group added a beautiful spirit to our weekend.

We now have **Regional Spiritual Assistants** from **Holy Name Province, Fr. Frank McHugh,** and **Stigmata Province** with **Bro. Doug Soik** continuing his service to our Region.

We have met with the **Provincial of Stigmata Province, Fr. Nick Mormondo, OFM Cap.** We are hoping to organize some visits to retired friars in both Stigmata and Holy Name Provinces.

**All of our fraternities were very generous this year.** We were able to contribute \$4,850 to the *Louisiana Flood Relief Appeal*. We also had wonderful collections of items to be donated to *Birthright, Several Sources, Blessed Bloomers and the Bergen County Human Services Shelter*.



# FORMATION CONVERSION

**I** often get frustrated with myself in my spiritual life because I seem to make the same mistakes over and over again.

No matter how hard I try and even with the best of my intentions, I often fall into the same traps of my own sinfulness and fail to recognize Christ in my brothers and sisters. It seems this happens most often while I'm driving home in traffic on Rt. 3 after a hard day's work and someone cuts me off or weaves in and out of traffic endangering me and everyone else around them.

But just when I'm most frustrated, I'm reminded of our *Rule* and that as Franciscans we are called to a "radical interior change which the gospel calls conversion" and that "this conversion be carried out daily." (see *OFS Rule 2:7*)

This past October, Ron Pihokker, OFS, North Jersey Councilor, sponsored a Cluster Formation class on conversion for all initial formation candidates and their Formation Director and Sponsors. The class was attended by over 15 people from fraternities in Northern New Jersey.

The formation class was wide-ranging and covered the topics of the Spirituality of Conversion, Insights from Scripture, Conversion and Sacrament, Conversion in Theology Today and the Order of Penitence in History.

One insight from the class that has helped me in my spiritual journey is Ron's observation that we can only truly comprehend conversion in glimpses.

He was 71 years old when he quietly passed away at the Our Lady of Angels Retirement Home in Joliet, Illinois, where his health had seriously and rapidly been declining. A Friar for 47 years, Fr. Benet was ordained a Priest, June 3, 1972, (44 years) and served parishes in Texas, Illinois and Missouri. He had a bachelor of philosophy degree from Quincy University; a master of arts in theology from DePaul University; a master of divinity degree from the Catholic Theological Union; and a degree in journalism from Marquette University.

Friar Benet was actively involved with the Secular Franciscans, he served as the General Spiritual Assistant for the OFS in Rome from 1980-1985. Updating the Ritual of the Secular Franciscan Order, he also provided several commentaries for our revised Rule and Constitutions and facilitated a deeper commitment to the spiritual life. He greatly encouraged community participation and apostolic endeavors.

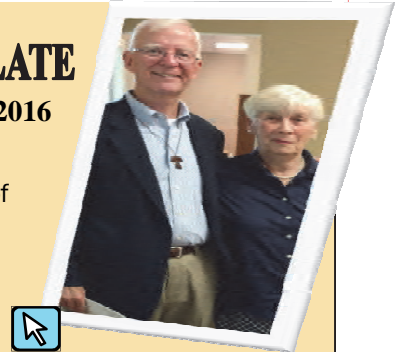


## NEW APOSTOLATE October 16, 2016

When Apostolate reps, Gerard and Karen Duffy, (above right) arrived to pick up the items, they filled five (5) carloads full of supplies.

It was a great success and again, brought tremendous awareness of our Fraternity to the parish.

Their mission is to collect and deliver a surplus of food from supermarkets/bakeries, etc. to soup kitchens in Harlem, the Bronx, Manhattan, Newark, Plainfield, the Contemplative Sisters in the Bronx and to unwed mothers in Brooklyn run by *Missionaries of Charity*. Food is also distributed to local areas of need such as *Lunch Break* and the *Salvation Army* in Red Bank, the *Missionaries of Charity* at Asbury Park, *Project Paul* and *St. Mark's Soup Kitchen* in Keansburg, the *2nd Baptist Church* in Long Branch, and *Broken Loaves* in Matawan, to name a few organizations. Food is also given to the *Franciscans of the Renewal* in the South Bronx and Newark to feed the poor.

They subscribe to Mother Teresa's principles, which are daily prayer and divine providence. Pray every day and believe God will provide. It's as simple as that. They abide by Mother Teresa's rule excluding all forms of fund-raising.
